SUGGESTED USE

Limonene F-300 is a non-ionic citrus extract, formulated for use in agriculture, nurseries and industry as a wetting and activating agent. Testing has shown **Limonene F-300** has been very effective when used with registered insecticides, herbicides, defoliants and desiccants for controlling insects, weeds and crop defoliation. Tank mixes using **Limonene F-300** with specific pesticides should be mixed per manufacture's label and field tested to determine optimum results.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in any manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Limonene F-300** should be added to mix at one to two quart per 100 gallons for most applications. User should read spray oil label for directions and general information for specific rates of application for insect control. **Limonene F-300** should be added to tank mix at the end

of the filling process. This should prevent excessive foaming. Successful depending upon the severity of pest pressure, temperature and application skills. Do not add adjuvant at a level that would exceed 5% of the finished spray volume.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not store near heat or open flame. Keep upright in a cool place in original container.

DISPOSAL: Triple rinse empty containers, then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary land fill, or other procedure approved by state and local authority.

IN CASE OF SPILLS: Recover all material practical for use. Soak up balance with sand, dirt or absorbent, and haul to approved land fill, check local regulation.
